Phase I - in each group all teams play all other teams - all 7 individual matches are played.

System of Play - A v Y, B v X, C v Z, Doubles, A v X, C v Y, B v Z.

Phase II - Knockout stages - matches played to a result.

In the Boys' School Team and Girls' School Team Competitions the 8 teams placed 1st or 2nd in the group will go forward to the play-off stages for places 1 - 8. The other teams will play off for the minor places.

In the Boys' National/Selected Team and Girls' National/Selected Team Competitions the 4 teams placed 1st or 2nd in the group will go forward to the play-off for places 1 - 4. The other teams will play off for the minor places.

The Technical Commission reserve the right to modify the groups should teams withdraw or additional teams be accepted before the commencement of the championships.
